

## After School Program Lead

This position is the ideal way to enhance your non-profit working experience while going to school! The position is designed to help you develop programming and leadership skills. If you enjoy spending time with kids, are excited to help them learn and develop, and want to develop your professional programming and leadership skills, this position is for you!

Essential functions and duties include:

- Leadership of an Afterschool program, Cub Scout &/or Boy Scout unit which will meet within the designated Boys and Girls Club locations
- Demonstration of knowledge and experience of Cub Scout or Boy Scout involvement
- Develop lesson plans and delivering Cub Scout &/or Boy Scout programming to boys
- Availability during after school hours for 1 hour per week
- Prior experience with non-profit institutions and lesson development a plus
- Secure supplies and materials as needed for programming with Program Coordinator.
- Ability to communicate effectively with professional staff and boys of Cub Scout & Boy Scout age
- Ability to work under limited supervision

Minimum requirements for position:

- Prior experience with and ability to plan and use a Cub Scout &/or Boy Scout program
- Minimum 3 hour commitment per week. More hours available with request and availability to serve at multiple locations:
  1. 1.5 hours preparation of program delivery
  2. .5 hours preparation at meeting location prior to delivery
  3. 1 hour program delivery
- Must have background in Cub and Scout programming. Ideal candidate would be an Eagle Scout or have Cub or Scout camp staff experience
- Must wear a Boy Scout uniform when providing program
- Must be 18 years old or older
- Must be able to provide own transportation Sites are in Pierce and Thurston counties
- Must be reliable and punctual when interacting with youth members and B&GC staff

Employment Terms:

- Compensation will be \$11 per hour after probationary period.
- 3 hours per week per location throughout school year. May work multiple locations due to availability.
- Must be willing to comply with background check and initial training provided by Boy Scouts and Boys and Girls Club.
