Powder Horn is an Outdoor / High Adventure recourse management course.....designed to motivate and prepare adult and youth leaders to provide their unit with a safe and correct Outdoor / High Adventure activities.

This course will give all the participants an opportunity to experience some of the many different Outdoor / High Adventure activities. It will also provide local resources necessary to successfully participate in these activities in several ways, including the following:

- Help adult and youth leaders safely conduct outdoor activities of a Fun and Challenging nature.
- Provide an introduction / exposure to the resources necessary to successfully lead a unit through an Outdoor / High Adventure program.
- Familiarize Venturers, Scouts, and Scouters with the various Scouting Outdoor / High Adventure programs so that they can help Scouts successfully meet their requirements (Shooting Sports Awards, Outdoors Awards, Sailing / Motor Boating Awards, etc.)

## POWDER HORN APPLICATION

A \$50 non-refundable\* deposit to hold my place is enclosed with this application. The balance of the total early registration fee of \$225 will be paid, no later than April 6, 2012. If the balance is not paid by April 6, 2012, the balance of the late registration fee of \$250 will be due no later than May 4, 2012. I understand that the Pacific Harbors Council Powder Horn Course is scheduled for two full weekends: from June 1-3, and June 22-24, 2012. I realize that participation for both full weekends is required, although I will not be forced to participate in any activity that I choose not to. I understand that this course is physically demanding and will include backcountry activities. Participation will require obtaining my physician's concurrence on a BSA High Adventure Class III physical form.

**This course is perfect for: Venturing Leaders, Sea Scout Leaders, Boy Scout Leaders, Cub Scout Leaders, Commissioners, District, Council Leaders, Professional Staff, and Youth.**

**Participant Qualifications: All adults & youth must be registered members of the BSA and must have completed Venturing Youth Protection. Adults must have completed Leader Specific Training for their position and be able to meet physical requirements and have a signed and current BSA medical form. Youth must be age 14 (or have joined a Venturing crew if 13 and finished 8<sup>th</sup> grade) and completed their unit's version of Leadership Training (Introduction to Leadership Skills for Troop or Introduction to Leadership Skills for Crew), and have a signed BSA medical form. More pre-course training on line may be required, prior to the course, and participants will be notified in that event. Do to the nature of the course, our locations are subject to change and day trips to local consultants events are likely.**

**Course Size: The course is limited to no more than 48 participants. Once the course is filled, you will be placed on a waiting list and called if there are cancellations. Out of council participants may attend, so sign up early as this course will likely fill up quickly. This course is the only one being held in Western Region Area 1 this year so we expect to fill fast. Be sure to get your application in quickly or you may end up on the waiting list.**
