

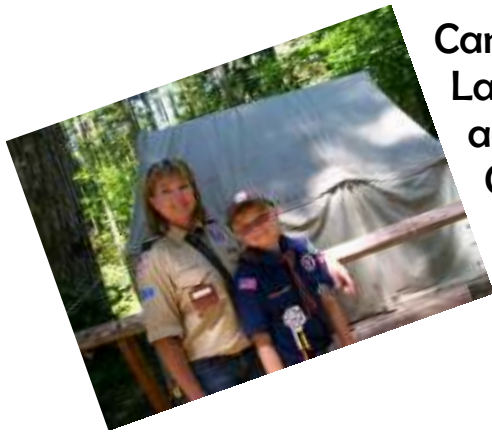

How to Register for Camp

The fee for Family Camps is \$60 and for an additional sibling Cub Scout it is an extra \$30. Each Cub Scout can be accompanied by their mother or other female family member for **Mom & Me**, father or male family member for **Lad & Dad** and either gender for **Pal & Me**. The adult must be over 18 years of age. Packs are encouraged to sign up together; however, each family has to complete a separate registration form.

Once you have arrived at Camp Thunderbird check in at the Camp Office where you will be assigned a heated cabin for the night. You will meet your host and be guided to your cabin to meet your fellow cabin mates. There are five heated cabins that sleep 14 Scouts and 14 Adults in bunks with mattresses. The Cub Scouts will sleep on one side of the cabin and the parents on the other. There is a full restroom on each end of the cabin that includes showers.

Throughout the day, dens will experience archery instruction, BB gun shooting, crafts, games, skit training and a nature activity. The meals (Breakfast and Lunch) will be served in the dining hall. There will be a campfire on Friday evening along with a cracker-barrel snack.

What to bring – You will need to bring your personal items like towels, toothbrushes, toothpaste, soap, sleeping bag, pillows, shampoo, comb, flashlight, extra batteries, etc. All campers need to wear shoes that are comfortable. No sandals or open-toed shoes, please! You also need to bring a field scout uniform to wear at breakfast and at the closing when we do flag ceremonies. The weather changes quickly in this area. Please be prepared for typical fall or spring weather with warm jackets and rain gear. We also have a Camp Trading Post open during camp.
