Dear Cub Scout & Families:

Welcome to Camp Thunderbird!

Your camping experience is just around the corner and we are anxiously awaiting your arrival! Information for the Webelos course offerings are also attached to this email and it will provide us with the Scouts choices of offerings for our Pioneering adventure.

Please find attached a new Camp Thunderbird Leader's Guidebook. This guide book will help answer many of your questions that you may have. Included also is the suggested listing of what to bring to camp with you. If this is your first Cub Scout resident camp, you will have a great time with our program staff and sleeping in the great outdoors. As a reminder, Camp Thunderbird is set in a beautiful, rustic location located on Lake Summit. Be prepared with suntan lotions and lotion bug spray. No aerosol cans are allowed at camp.

**NEW THIS YEAR! In the leaders guide, you will find a new form called "Temporary Guardianship."** If you are bringing to camp with you some scouts from your Pack that are not coming with their adult, please have the parental guardian fill out this form. It will help in providing additional information for us.

When you will arrive at camp you will be given a program schedule for the days ahead. As a reminder all Cub Scouts will be required to dress in full field uniform (blue/tan shirts, hats, neck scarves) for all meals and flag presentations. We will be providing all Cub Scouts with a camp class B activity shirt. Adults may purchase a t-shirt at the Camp Trading Post.

At the conclusion of camp, families are invited to join us for a BBQ lunch, then stay for the closing campfire and awards. Lunch will begin at approximately 12:30 pm. The cost for a guest lunch ticket is \$8.00 per adult and \$4.00 for children ages 12 and under. Closing campfire will begin approximately at 2:00 pm and conclude around 3:00 pm. After campfire, we will do our last check-out procedures for all campers and scouts will be heading home. All scouts will need to be picked-up no later than 3:30 pm on the closing day.
