

How to Get Your "Bobcat"

Parents...Test you son on these five Bobcat requirements. When he has learned them, sign below. He must then take this slip to his den leader. His Bobcat badge will be presented to him at a Pack Meeting.

1. Learn and give the Cub Scout Promise:

I _____, promise to do my best to do my duty to God and my country. To help other people, and obey the Law of the Pack.



In the Cub Scout Promise you say you will try hard to practice your religious duties. You say you will stand up for your country. You say you will be honest and fair to everyone and you obey the Law of the Pack.

2. Say and explain the Law of the Pack:

The Cub Scout follows Akela. The Cub Scout helps the pack go. The pack helps the Cub Scout grow. The Cub Scout gives goodwill.

"Akela" means "good leader" to a Cub Scout. In the Law of the Pack, you say you will follow Akela. This means you will follow people like your Cub Scout leaders. You also say you will help the pack go, you will go to your Cub Scout meetings. If you do that, the Cub Scout leaders will help you learn new things. You will learn games and tricks and things to make. The last part of the Law of the Pack says, "The Cub Scout gives goodwill". This means you will try to help other people all you can.

3. Show and explain the Cub Scout Sign and Handshake:

Make the sign with your right hand high over your shoulder. The two fingers remind the Cub Scout of the alert ears of the wolf. They stand for two parts of the Cub Scout Promise "Help other people" and "obey the Law of the Pack".

4. The Handshake:

When you shake hands with another Cub Scout, place the first two fingers of the right hand on the other boy's wrist.

5. Explain and give the Cub Scout Motto and Salute:

The Motto A motto is a rule for living. The Cub Scout Motto asks you to do the best you can always.

"Do Your Best" You may not be able to do something as well as another. Don't worry, just do as well as you can.

The Salute Hold the first two fingers of your right hand close together. Touch them to your cap. Use this salute when you greet a Cub Scout leader, to show goodwill to another Cub Scout, and to give respect to the flag when in uniform.
